Brochures, calendars, stationery, cards and promotional material can all be designed and printed by Prestige.

And Prestige has invested in quality. In the last three years it has spent £300,000 on state-of-the-art design and printing equipment.

Dhiren qualified at the world famous London School of Printing in the 1970s and all of the brothers take a hands-on approach.

When they started out in 1987, the brothers took on just six staff. Now there are 22 people working for the company.

means staff stay and the quality of service and the products remain consistent because employees know what the customers expect.

As well as the high-tech needs of the printing and design process, the company has also invested in important administration systems.

That means there are records available so the company knows what its customers' needs are at the touch of a button.

It serves a host of big local companies but also has customers around the country.

"If one of our customers moves out of the local area they tend to stick with us, says Dhiren.

After such a successful first 10 years, at first glance it appears hard to keep the

expansion going.

But Dhiren says that concentrating on quality and service will lay the foundations for even more growth.

"We have grown as Telford has grown and it is great to be part of such a vibrant town.

"We have had a great 10 years and the British Standard Award is something we are really proud of.

"We would like to thank all our customers and suppliers for their loyalty and hope to give them at least another 10 years service," he says.
